## What is biblio?

- **Academic bibliography & institutional archive:**
  - **Academic bibliography:**  
publication list UGent researchers.
  - **Institutional archive** ('institutional repository'): archive of full texts of UGent publications.
- Biblio integrates both.

# Classification

# Articles

- **A1:** in ISI Web of Science indexes:
  - 'Science Citation Index'
  - 'Social Science Citation Index'
  - 'Arts and Humanities Citation Index'.
- Only doc. types: article, review, letter/note, proceedings paper.

**NOT A1:** Emerging Sources Citation  
Index (ESCI)

# Articles

- **A2:** in scholarly journal with peer review
- **A4:** in a scholarly journal without peer review (but newspaper article, magazine, newsletter, etc -> V)

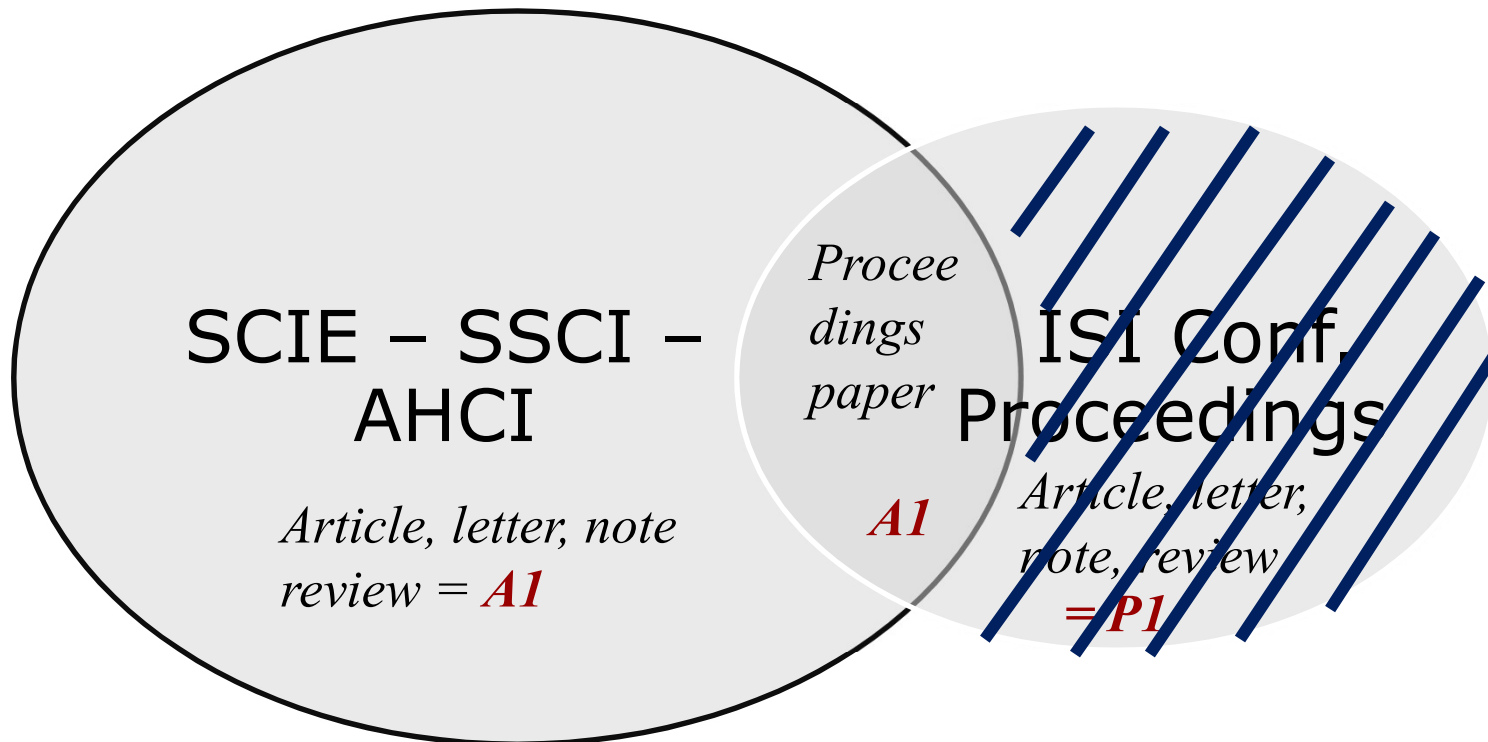
# Conference output

- **P1**: in proceedings indexes in ISI Web of Science:
  - 'Conference Proceedings Citation Index – Science'
  - 'Conference Proceedings Citation Index – Social Science and Humanities'.
- Only types: article, review, letter/note, proceedings paper.




# Conference output



- **C1:** published article in conference proceedings. (Not a1, a2 or p1) -> no abstracts or presentations!
- **C3:** other conference output: presentation / meeting abstract / poster / ppt



Tip: select the appropriate database in Web of Science to recognize A1 / P1

# Books

- **B1:** author or co-author books
- **B2:** author or co-author, chapter in a book
- **B3:** editor or co-editor, book

# VABB-SHW

- Vlaams Academisch Bibliografisch Bestand - Sociale en Humane Wetenschappen (Flemish academic bibliographic database – social and sciences and humanities)
- Public database containing publications in social sciences and humanities, published by researchers affiliated with Flemish universities
- Based on the academic bibliographies of the Flemish universities

## Biblio > VABB

- Fill out the necessary fields for VABB, although these fields are not mandatory in Biblio:  
**Volume, Issue, pages, number of pages, ISSN/ISBN**
- Find your VABB approved publications in Biblio via 'Advanced Search': fill out your personnel number in 'author' and select 'only VABB approved publications' at the bottom of the page. Do the same for "editor"
- Approval process only finishes about two years after publication. Consequently publications of last year cannot be approved yet

## Other

- **D1-publication:** phd thesis
- **V-publication:** All other publications such as book review, bibliography, lemma, report / working paper, e.a.

# Mandated deposit PHD

- Based on the education and exam regulations
  - Art. 93 §1: In any case, an electronic version of the doctoral dissertation also needs to be submitted and each doctoral dissertation is to include a Dutch and English summary.
  - Art. 94 §5: The Technology Transfer Office aspires to ensure the legal protection of the research results that can create value prior to the public defence of the doctoral dissertation
  - Art. 97 §7: After the successful public defence of their doctorate, doctoral students are to provide the university library with a digital copy of their doctoral dissertation. Without detracting from the rights of the author, Ghent University or third parties, the university library will make the doctoral dissertation accessible by way of an open access system.



## Not in Biblio

- Master theses: are submitted via Minerva and transferred to the university library for archive and access

## Mandate immediate deposit

- Immediate deposit / optional Open Access
- **Types:** all except C3 and V
  - B3: only content table + cover + preface
  - D1: is not covered by this mandate but through OER
- Be careful: no full text = not public and not counted internally

# Why deposit?

- Top of result lists
- Publication list
- Embed in website
- Exports (per departement, author, etc.)
  - Endnote, Bibtex, Excel, Word, FWO, BOF
- Preservation
- Visibility and reputation
- Financing and evaluation
