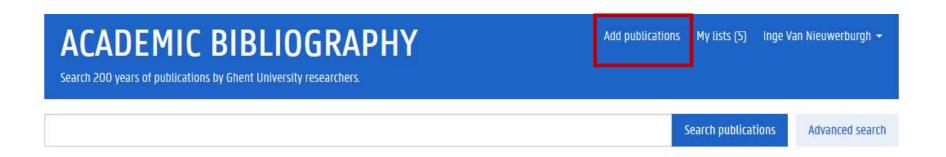

a1.1 Papers

- (a) included in the Science Citation Index, Social Science Citation Index or Arts and Humanities Citation Index in Web of Science, limited to the following document types: "Article", "Review", "Letter", "Note", "Proceedings paper"
- (b) in journals included in Journal Citation Reports, listed in descending chronological order, including the **impact factor in the year of publication** (or the most recent one).
- **a1.2** Peer reviewed papers published in journals approved by the authoritative panel of the 'Vlaams Academisch Bibliografisch Bestand in de Sociale en Humane Wetenschappen (VABB SHW)', listed in chronological order
- **a2** Papers published in scientific journals, which are not included in (a1), listed in chronological order.

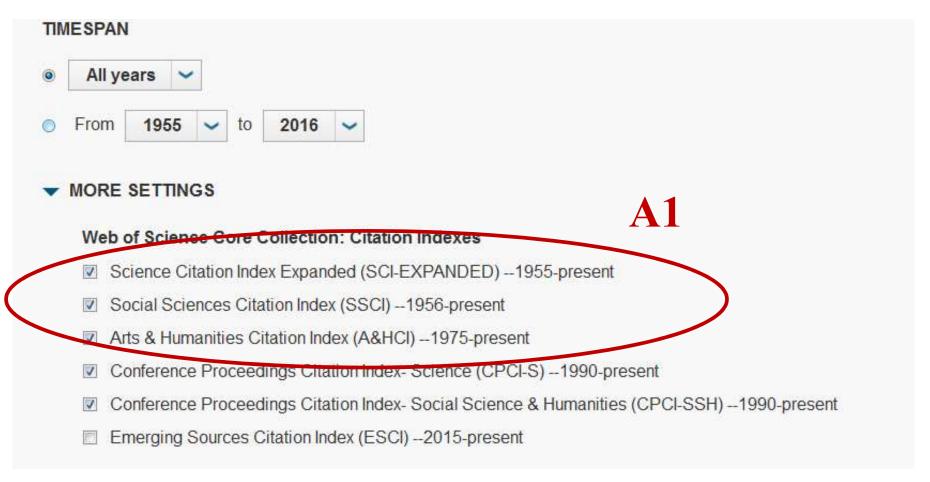


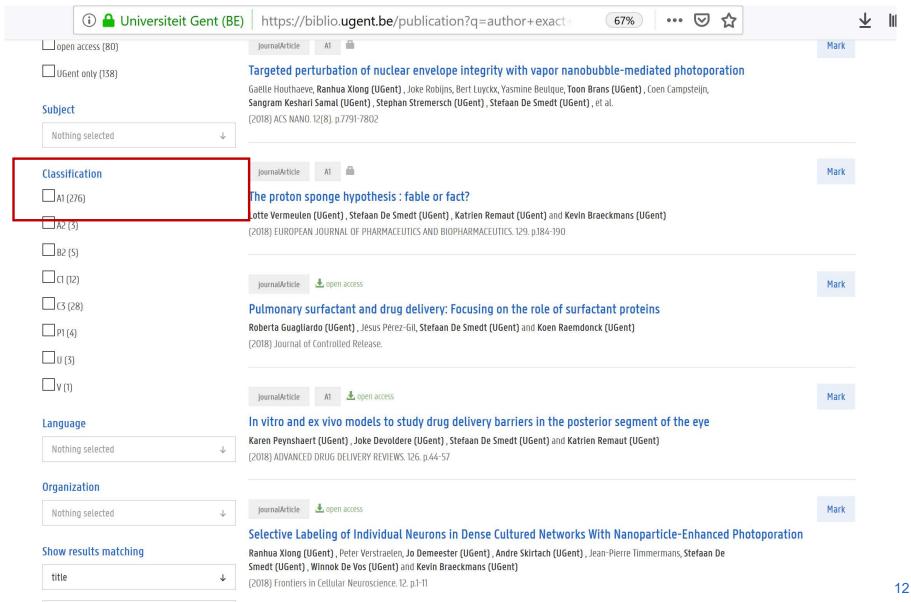

- = A2 AND in <u>journal list VABB</u> (not automatically in FWO export: add manually!). Mind that articles only get a VABB label after 2 years, so don't forget to add possible VABB articles of the last 2 years. This is the option to do that



When applying for a grant at FWO, researchers have to present a list of publications according to FWO's classific directly into the FWO online application wizard. Researchers affiliated with UGent can import their publications bulk.

Download all in FWO format

You'll notice that FWO does not copy all the available metadata fields from the Biblio export. You'll also notice t imported. You can fine tune all publications in the FWO application wizard after import. Notedly, your dissertati directly in the FWO wizard.

To make comparisons before/after import easier, we'd advise you to export the different categories one by one control, you could create custom lists in Biblio for publications you individually select and which you know to bi Biblio can be exported to FWO.



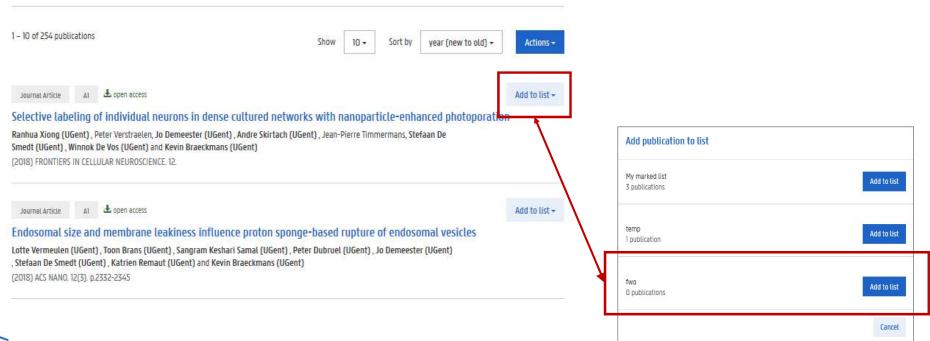

 Filter out the publications you want to upload to the FWO form and add them to the dedicated list

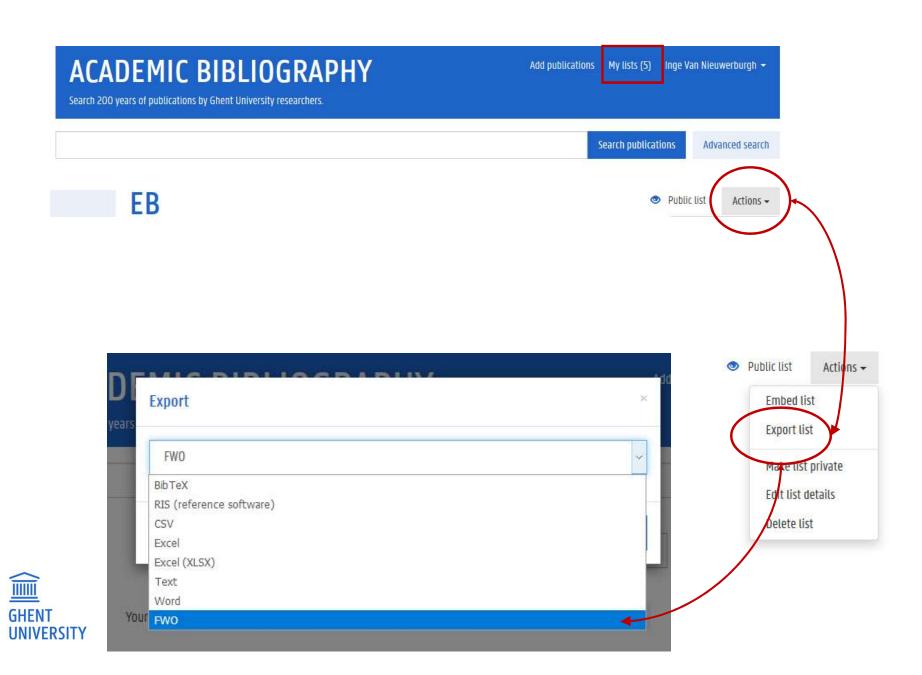




SELECTION OF PUBLICATIONS

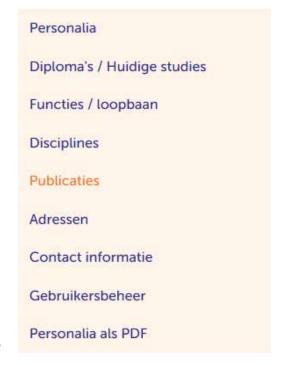
